10 11	Amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:
12	<pre>'Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA \$1017, sub-\$2, ¶F, as enacted</pre>
13	by PL 1985, c. 161, \$6 and as amended by PL 1985, c.
14	383, \$14, is further amended to read:
15	F. Unless further reports will be filed in rela-
16	tion to a later election in the same calendar
17	year, the disposition of any surplus or deficit
18	in excess of \$50 shown in the reports described
19	in paragraph E shall be reported <u>quarterly</u> to the
20	commission en the first day within 15 days fol-
21	lowing the end of each quarter of the State's
22	fiscal year, until the surplus is disposed of or
23	the deficit is liquidated. The first report is
24	not required until the first 15th day of the
25	quarter beginning at least 90 days from the date
26	of the election. The reports may either be filed
27	in person with the commission on that date or
28	postmarked by that time on that date. The reports
29	must set forth any contributions for the purpose
30	of liquidating the deficit, in the same manner as
31	contributions are set forth in other reports re-
32	quired in this section.'
33	Further amend the Bill by inserting at the begin-
34	ning of the first line after the enacting clause
35	(page 1, line 22 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 2.'
36	Further amend the Bill in paragraph D by insert-
37	ing after the first sentence (page 1, line 32 in

3	least 90 days from the date of the election.'
4	STATEMENT OF FACT
5 6 7 8 9 10	The purpose of this amendment is to delay the re- porting date for each quarterly gubernatorial candi- date's campaign report, which reports a surplus or deficit, to 15 days after the quarter begins. This makes the changes for candidates for Governor and candidates for other offices consistent.
11 12 13	This amendment also delays the first quarterly report to the 15th day of the quarter which begins at least 90 days after the election.
