24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	1-A. Municipal watercraft registration. Rules authorizing the commissioner to delegate to municipalities the authority to issue watercraft registrations. These rules shall include provisions for the municipalities to retain reasonable administrative costs from fees collected. With the approval of the municipal officers of a municipality, the commissioner may appoint municipal clerks, tax collectors or such other persons that a municipality may designate as agents to issue watercraft registrations.
34 35 36	Agents may charge a service fee of not more than \$1 for each watercraft registration issued and this service fee shall be retained by the municipality.

- Each municipal agent shall report to the commissioner on or before the 15th day of each calendar month. The report shall include an accounting of all watercraft registration issued during the previous calendar month and shall be accompanied by:
- 6 A. The department's copy of each registration issued; and
- 8 B. All watercraft registration funds collected by the agent during the reporting period;

                         STATEMENT OF FACT
27
          The purpose of this bill is to provide for regis-
      trations of watercraft at the local level and elimi-
28

      nate the inconvenience and delay frequently experi-
      enced by boat owners in having to send to Augusta be-

      fore they can use their boat. Under the provisions of
31

      this bill, a boat owner will be able to pay his wa-
33
      tercraft excise tax and register his boat by
34
      one stop at the municipal office in the town where he
35
      resides.

This bill also reduces the watercraft registration period from 2 years to one year. Annual registration is consistent with the watercraft excise tax and facilitates the annual collection of these taxes by the municipalities.

 The watercraft registration fee will be increased by \$1 annually to cover additional administrative costs associated with the tabulation of monthly reports from 500 municipalities and the automation of 120,000 watercraft on an annual basis. In addition, municipalities retain a \$1 service fee for each registration issued.

A companion bill amending the watercraft excise tax law will be heard before the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation.
