STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill makes payment of an insurance policy 3 dividend conditional upon renewal of an insurance 4 policy a defined unfair trade practice. As dividends 5 are based on experience for the prior year, they 6 should be paid regardless of whether the policy is 7 renewed.

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
