Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

35 MRSA §73-A is enacted to read:

§73-A. Apportionment of costs for water system extension or expansion

Notwithstanding any rule or regulation to the contrary, the governing body of a municipal water department or quasi-municipal water district may require new customers to advance to the municipal water department or quasi-municipal water district on a nonrefundable basis an amount equivalent to the actual cost of providing service, including costs associated with extension of water mains or expansion of the water system.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

24 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow for the apportionment of the cost of water system extensions and expansions in an equitable manner and is intended to promote rate fairness among customers.

This bill shall be regarded as supplemental and additional to powers conferred by other laws and shall not be regarded as in derogation of any powers now existing.
