18 AN ACT to Adjust and Allocate Various  
19 Dedicated Revenue Accounts of the  
20 Department of Environmental Protection for  
21 Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1986, and  
22 June 30, 1987.

24 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
25 lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
26 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

27 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-  
28 til late in fiscal year 1986 or early in fiscal year  
29 1987; and

30 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-  
31 dent to the operation of the Department of Environ-  
32 mental Protection will become due and payable during  
33 the period of April to June, 1986, and immediately  
34 after July 1, 1986; and

1           Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of  
3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
6 therefore,

7           Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
8 follows:

9           Sec. 1. Allocation of the Ground Water Oil  
10 Clean-up Fund. Allocation of the Ground Water Oil  
11 Clean-up Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
12 1986, is adjusted and the fund is allocated for the  
13 fiscal year ending June 30, 1987, as designated in  
14 the following schedule:

1           Section 2 provides for adequate personal services  
2 funding in the Maine Coastal and Inland Surface Oil  
3 Clean-up Fund for fiscal year 1986 and allocates this  
4 fund for fiscal year 1987.

5           Section 3 provides for adequate personal services  
6 funding in the Maine Hazardous Waste Fund for fiscal  
7 year 1986 and allocates this fund for fiscal year  
8 1987.

9           Section 4 provides for adequate personal services  
10 funding in the Radioactive Waste Evaluation Fund,  
11 formerly Low-level Waste Siting Fund, for the fiscal  
12 years 1986 and 1987.

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
