COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1246, L.D.
1756, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the School Construction
Law."

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and
before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective untl 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, some municipalities will be holding ref-
erendum votes on school construction in conjunction
with the June primary election; and

Whereas, nonemergency bills will not take effect
untl July if the Legislature adjourns in April; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, '

Futher amend the bill by inserting before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
proved.'
