12 13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective unitl 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16 17	Whereas, some municipalities will be holding referendum votes on school construction in conjunction with the June primary election; and
18 19	Whereas, nonemergency bills will not take effect unitl July if the Legislature adjourns in April; and
20 21 22 23 24 25	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
26 27	Futher amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:
28 29 30	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
