STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clarifies present law by exempting the State from the Used Car Information Act. This allows the Department of Finance and Administration to continue selling state-owned surplus vehicles to the public at auction. These auctions not only add substantial amounts to the General Fund but also allow the public an opportunity to bid on items their tax dollars originally purchased.

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
