12 13 14	'Sec. 7. 12 MRSA §5162, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 451, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
15	§5162. Volunteer insurance
16 17 18	The State Environmental Resource Volunteer Effort Program shall ensure that volunteers are covered by workplace injury and liability insurance.'
19 20	Further amend the Amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

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SENATE AMENDMENT " $_{\mbox{A}}$ " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1251, L.D. 1761

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment corrects an error in the original law which created the State Environmental Resource 3 Volunteer Effort Program, the volunteer arm of the Maine Conservation Corps. The current law requires 4 5 6 the State to provide insurance for participants. Par-7 ticipants may already have insurance either individu-8 ally or through groups or institutions they are af-9 filiated with. This amendment requires the State to 10 provide insurance only if participants do not other-11 wise have injury and liability insurance, thus avoid-12 ing duplicating the purchase of insurance. It is expected that this amendment will save \$1,000 to \$2,000 13 14 in insurance coverage payments each year.
