1761, Bill, "AN ACT to Expand the Maine Conservation
Corps."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 7
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 7. Contracts. The department may enter in-
to contracts with state agencies and nonprofit em-
ployment and training organizations for the adminis-
tration and payment of participant wages and other
related activities. Where such a contract is entered
into, the department may transfer out, and any re-
ceiving state agency may transfer in and expend, nec-
essary funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.
