24 follows:

25 5 MRSA §791 is enacted to read:

26 §791. Records confidential

27 Records and correspondence utilized by state
28 agencies in the certification of minority business
29 enterprises, women's business enterprises and disad-
30 vantaged business enterprises which pertain to the
31 applicant's financial or tax status, to private con-
32 tracts made by the applicant, to the applicant's
33 trade secrets or to any other matter customarily re-
34 garded as confidential business information shall be
35 confidential and shall not be open for public inspec-
36 tion.
