COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 684, L.D. 1772, Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Resources of the Advisory Commission on Radioactive Waste and Allocate Funds from the Radioactive Waste Fund."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. 38 MRSA §1454, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

8. One-time assessment. There shall be a one-time assessment of \$36,000 levied by the department, on a pro rata basis, against all license holders of record as of January 1, 1986.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the Radioactive Waste Evaluation Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
