COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 699, L.D.
1784, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Set-back Requirements
under the Shoreland Zoning Law."

Amend the bill in subsection 5 by striking out 10 the last underlined sentence (page 1, lines 33 to 36 11 12 and page 2, lines 1 and 2 in the L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'This subsection is not intended to prohibit a board of appeals from granting 13 14 a variance to the set-back requirements in compliance 15 16 with Title 30, section 4963, subsection 3, nor is it 17 intended to prohibit the expansion of a nonconforming 18 use or structure where otherwise allowed by ordi-19 nance.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that any variance which a municipal board of appeals may grant to the set-back requirements in the shoreland zoning must be granted in compliance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30, section 4963, subsection 3. That subsection requires that a variance be granted only in the case of undue hardship and defines what constitutes undue hardship.
