Whereas, Acts of the Legis-12 13 lature do not become effective until 90 days after 14 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15 Whereas, the bargaining process between agricultural producers and processors of agricultural products must occur within a structured framework 16 17 18 with dates specified for negotiating contracts; and 19 Whereas, the broiler industry is currently nego-20 tiating a new contract with a major processor under 21 terms which are affected by these amendments to the 22 Maine Agricultural Marketing and Bargaining Act of 23 1973; and 24 Whereas, it is imperative to insure that conditions support the negotiation of contracts which maintain the economic standing of agricultural pro-25 26 27 ducers and processors in Maine; and 28 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 29 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 30 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 31 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-32 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 33 therefore,' 34 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end

before the statement of fact the following:
