17 AN ACT to Fund Training for Boards of
18 Directors of Social Service Agencies.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §5310, sub-§14-A is enacted to
23 read:

24 14-A. Training of boards. Provide consultation
25 and funding for programs presented by state-funded,
26 nonprofit hospitals, nursing homes, day care centers
27 and mental health and retardation agencies for the
28 training of their boards of directors.

29 This program shall be on a matching funds basis. The
30 department shall adopt such rules as may be necessary
31 to define eligibility for such services, contractual
32 terms, conditions for grants, matching ratios, quality
33 of performance standards and such others as are
34 necessary for the administration of this section.
35 These rules shall be published and subject to a
36 30-day public review prior to taking final effect.
