STATEMENT OF FACT

In certain instances, timely consideration of ap-15 16 plications to the Department of Environmental Protec-17 tion may require specialized technical expertise not 18 readily available within departmental staff. The 19 purpose of this bill is to provide a mechanism where-20 by the department and the applicant mutually agree on 21 the need for outside technical expertise to be ac-22 quired at the expense of the applicant, but in all 23 other ways selected and otherwise under the control 24 of the department.
