SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1284, L.D. 1801

1 STATEMENT OF FACT This amendment changes the definition of "political action committee" to include persons who expend 3 more than \$50 in an election. This will not limit an individual's contributions or expenditures, but will 5 require him to report as a political action committee 7 does if he expends in excess of \$50 in an election. 8 The original bill deletes the subchapter on referendum campaign financing and this amendment attempts to close any loopholes left by that deletion. 10 11 6714030686 (Sen.
