17 AN ACT to Increase the Eligibility Guidelines  
18 under the Elderly Householders Tax and  
19 Rent Refund Act and the Elderly Low  
20 Cost Drug Program.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
23 follows:

24 36 MRSA §5108, first ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c.  
25 698, §189, is further amended to read:

26 No claim otherwise allowable may be granted to  
27 claimants of single member households with household  
28 income in excess of \$5,600 in calendar year 1980 and  
29 ~~\$6,200~~ \$7,000 in each succeeding year for which re-  
30 lief is requested; and no claim otherwise allowable  
31 may be granted to claimants of ~~households~~ households  
32 of 2 or more members with income in excess of \$6,700  
33 in calendar year 1980 and ~~\$7,400~~ \$8,000 in each suc-  
34 ceeding year for which relief is requested.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           This bill raises the income eligibility limits  
3 under the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund  
4 Act and the Elderly Low Cost Drug Program up to  
5 \$7,000 for single member households and \$8,000 for  
6 households of more than one member.

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
