COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1292, L.D.  
1809, Bill, "AN ACT to Improve Whitewater Rafting."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 7  
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 7. 12 MRSA §7369, sub-§10, ¶C, as enacted  
by PL 1983, c. 502, §4, is amended to read:

C. An outfitter may occasionally exceed the al-  
location by 2 passengers on a trip of up to 40  
passengers, or 4 passengers on a trip of up to 80  
passengers, to accommodate ~~unexpected friends of~~  
passengers problems in booking, provided that the  
average of the number of passengers carried on an  
outfitter's 10 best allocated days for each river  
and for each allocated day of the week does not  
exceed his allocation for that river and day.  
Abuse of this privilege will result in its loss.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the  
Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 10. Allocation. The following funds are  
allocated for the Department of Inland Fisheries and  
Wildlife to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           This amendment puts back the provision that com-  
3           mercial rafters may, in specific circumstances, ex-  
4           ceed their daily allocation but adds the requirement  
5           that the average of their 10 best allocated days may  
6           not exceed their allocation. It also adds an alloca-  
7           tion of \$600 to pay for the extension of the  
8           Whitewater Advisory Committee.
