An outfitter may occasionally exceed the allocation by 2 passengers on a trip of up to 40 passengers, or 4 passengers on a trip of up to 80 passengers, to accommodate unexpected friends of passengers problems in booking, provided that the average of the number of passengers carried on an outfitter's 10 best allocated days for each river and for each allocated day of the week does not exceed his allocation for that river and day. Abuse of this privilege will result in its loss.'

It also adds an allocation of \$600 to pay for the extension of the Whitewater Advisory Committee.
