AN ACT to Amend the Maine Certificate of Need Act
Relating to Departmental Authority to
Define Categories of Health Services
Subject to Review.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

22 MRSA §304-A, sub-§4, ¶C, as enacted by PL
1981, c. 705, Pt. V, §16, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill amends the Maine Certificate of Need
3 Act to repeal the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22,
4 section 304-A, subsection 4, paragraph C, which gives
5 the Department of Human Services broad power to de-
6 fine categories of health services which are subject
7 to review regardless of capital expenditure or oper-
8 ating cost.
