SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1307, L.D. 1823,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Paralytic Shellfish Poison  
Monitoring Program."

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part design-  
ated "§6742-A." in subsection 2 in the first line  
(page 2, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the follow-  
ing: "5%" and inserting in its place the following:  
'8%'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of  
section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are  
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the  
purposes of this Act.

3 established in this Act and shall make its report,  
4 including any necessary legislation, to the Second  
5 Regular Session of the 113th Legislature.

6 FISCAL NOTE

7 The appropriation in this Act will be offset by a  
8 like amount of revenue increase to the General Fund.'

9 STATEMENT OF FACT

10 This amendment sets the tax in order to pay for  
11 the costs of the monitoring program. The costs of  
12 the program are defined by monitoring program re-  
13 quirements deemed satisfactory for the protection of  
14 public health. Actual program costs were determined  
15 upon review subsequent to submission of the original  
16 bill.
