STATEMENT OF FACT

9 Currently, the total amount of funds available in Maine for public transportation services is insuffi-10 cient to meet the needs of Maine's citizens. Because 11 Maine is a rural, sparsely populated state, easy ac-12 cess to public transportation for some may be an un-13 realistic expectation. Volunteer drivers are pres-14 15 ently being utilized, but current numbers do not come close to addressing the need for services. This bill 15 allocates \$185,000 to expand the number of volunteer 17 13 drivers.

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
