## 3 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment eliminates a separate fund for educational purposes in the unorganized territory and
provides that financing of services will be covered
completely by appropriations from the General Fund
reimbursed by the Unorganized Territory Education and
Services Fund. It also provides that income from education related activities should be paid to the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund.
