IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SIX
AN ACT to Prohibit the Use of Public Money for the Construction or Maintenance of Private Ways.
Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
Whereas, public money, in the past, has been expended for the maintenance and improvement of private ways; and
Whereas, this practice of public financing of private ways is currently being expanded, including the unorganized townships; and
Whereas, public financing of private ways has been declared, in an Attorney General's opinion, to be in conflict with constitutional principles; and

Whereas, there is no clear statutory prohibition against this practice which officials in municipalities, counties and unorganized townships may follow with respect to use of public money; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

While this practice is 31 not authorized by law, there is no statutory prohibi-32 33 tion against the practice. This practice is or is 34 planned to be implemented in some areas of the State.

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While the expenditure of public money on private ways violates the Constitution of Maine, the law should be clear with respect to this prohibition, particularly for municipalities and counties which often adopt practices not prohibited by law. Constitutional provisions are often ignored in some counties and municipalities.
