This bill amends the legislation enacted by the 112th Legislature in the First Regular Session that established a Joint Select Committee on Economic Development. The purpose of the bill is to provide the Legislature with an overview of the economy of Maine and the efforts of governmental agencies and other bodies to promote and protect the economy. This bill requires the Joint Select Committee on Economic Development to obtain information about the economy of the State and the activities of state agencies and report its findings to the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature.

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
