	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	24 MRSA §2906 is enacted to read:
~	§2906. Malpractice insurance discrimination against certain physicians
	No insurer authorized to transact business in this State which writes or engages in writing medical malpractice insurance may refuse to insure or contin- le to insure, limit the amount, extent or kind of coverage available to any licensed physician solely because the insured or the applicant for insurance has a particular medical specialty or is engaged in a particular branch or type of medicine.
