20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	21-A MRSA §626, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1985, c. 277, is further amended to read:
24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32	1. Opening time flexible. Except in municipali- ties of population less than 100, the polls must be opened no earlier than 6 a.m. and no later than 9 a.m. on election day; except that in municipalities with a population of 2,500 or less, the polls must be opened no later than 10:00 a.m. on election day. The municipal officers of each municipality shall deter- mine the time of opening the polls within these lim- its.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill changes the law which requires all 3 polls to be open by 9 a.m. so that polls in smaller 4 municipalities would not have to be open until 10 5 a.m.
