17 AN ACT to Permit Administration of Home  
18 Winterization Programs on an Optional  
19 Basis Through Local Municipalities.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 22 MRSA §5203, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1983, c.  
24 482, §4, is further amended to read:

25 1. Administering organization. The Executive De-  
26 partment, Division of Community Services, shall ad-  
27 minister programs for weatherization as defined in  
28 section 5202, subsection 6, and fuel assistance as  
29 defined in section 5202, subsection 1. The division  
30 shall, by rule, permit a municipality to administer  
31 the programs directly if the municipality elects to  
32 do so.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2       Several municipalities have administered the home  
3 winterization programs for some time. This bill  
4 would permit municipalities to continue to administer  
5 those programs if they chose to do so.

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
