4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	Enactment of this bill requires a Highway Fund allocation of \$1,322,168 in fiscal year 1987. This amount will be in addition to the \$420,250 already included in the Division of Motor Vehicles budget for computer services. In the first year of establishing an independent computer system, the Division of Motor Vehicles will need to maintain its present link to Central Computer Services while establishing its own computer system.
13 14 15 16 17	In fiscal year 1988 and beyond, the Division of Motor Vehicles estimates that they will need an annual Highway Fund allocation of approximately \$184,000 to administer their computer system and will raise approximately \$20,400 in dedicated revenues from user fees.
19 20 21 22 23	In fiscal year 1988 and beyond, Central Computer Services will experience decreased revenues, approximately \$420,250, as the Division of Motor Vehicles will no longer need to pay Central Computer Services user fees.'
