STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The development of new and improved potato varieties, their evaluation for cultural, storage and mar-7 8 keting characteristics, and their release to the potato industry is critical to the economic growth of 9 Maine potato farms. This bill provides for joint 10 state and potato industry funding of potato breeding 11 and development work in the State and to accelerate potato development activity to speed the development 12 13 of more adaptable potato varieties on Maine potato 14 15 farms.

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
