AN ACT Pertaining to Fort Point State Park.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

The purpose of this bill is to construct on state property an access road and entrance to Fort Point State Park in Stockton Springs in Waldo County. Currently, the access route is located on private property.

In 1978, the State received permission to use private property for an access route to Fort Point State Park on the condition that the State would develop an access route on state property. Thus, the use of the private road was intended to be temporary until the State could construct its own road over state property.

This bill appropriates \$50,000 of General Fund money which will be matched with \$50,000 of federal money to construct the access road.
