26 27 28 29	The department shall provide reimbursement, to the maximum extent allowable, under the United States Social Security Act, Title XIX, for inpatient care and treatment of patients with mental diseases.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 Maine's new psychiatric and substance abuse hospital has not been able to provide the needed mental 3 4 health and substance abuse services to children because of external fiscal regulations and their own 5 fiscal operating requirements. The Department of Hu-man Services has expressed interest in these ser-6 7 8 vices, but has not acted on this interest. This bill directs the department to allow this hospital to serve children now being turned away because of no 9 10 medicaid reimbursement. The hospital's rates will be 11 12 comparable to similar services statewide.

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
