COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 741, L.D. 1894, "Resolve, Amending the Reporting Date of the Joint Select Committee for Learning Disabled Children."

Amend the resolve in the last paragraph before the emergency clause in the 8th and 9th lines (page 2, lines 28 and 29 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "The committee report shall include necessary proposed legislation."

Further amend the resolve by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

All Other \$2,000'

Further amend the resolve by inserting after the emergency clause and before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this resolve will require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$2,000 in fiscal year 1987. This resolve extends the Joint Select Committee for Learning Disabled Children reporting deadline from January 1, 1986, to January 1, 1987. The General Fund appropriation will fund additional
