20 21 22	Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §9083, first ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1985, c. 389, §7, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
23 24 25 26 27 28 29	The board shall establish a fee for a license to operate a mobile home park within the meaning of this subchapter. The fee shall include a base fee of \$30 plus an additional amount of up to \$3 per mobile home site. This fee must accompany each application for license, including applications for mobile home park expansion and renewal of license.'
