22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 38 MRS A §342-A is enacted to read:

25 §342-A. Notice to municipal officials

26 If the department learns of any alleged violation
27 of those laws enforced by the department which has a
28 direct impact on any real property within a munici-
29 pality or if the department takes any action that has
30 a direct impact on any real property within a munici-
31 pality, the department shall notify the municipal of-
32 icials of that municipality in writing of the al-
33 leged violation or the department action.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to require that mu-
3 nicipal officers be notified of any alleged viola-
4 tions of environmental protection laws and actions
5 taken by the Department of Environmental Protection
6 which concern that municipality.

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
