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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 757, L.D. 1921, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Staff Retention in Community-based Residential Facilities for Persons with Mental Retardation."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill in section 2, by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Members. The committee shall consist of 7 members as follows: One member of the Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate; one member of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; one member representing the private sector with experience in personnel recruitment and retention to be appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives; 3 members representing community-based facilities for persons with mental retardation to be appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and one member representing the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to be appointed by the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation. All members of the advisory committee, except for the representative from the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation, shall receive per diem for days of attendance at advisory committee meetings at the same rate as legislative per diem and shall be reimbursed for and expenses nourred in the performance of their duties, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 12202.'
