7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
8 to S.P. 757, L.D. 1921, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to
9 Staff Retention in Community-based Residential Facil-
10 ities for Persons with Mental Retardation."

11 Amend the amendment by striking out everything
12 after the title and inserting in its place the fol-
13 lowing:

14 'Amend the bill in section 2, by striking out all
15 of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the fol-
16 lowing:

17 '1. **Members.** The committee shall consist of 7
18 members as follows: One member of the Senate to be
19 appointed by the President of the Senate; one member
20 of the House of Representatives to be appointed by
21 the Speaker of the House of Representatives; one mem-
22 ber representing the private sector with experience
23 in personnel recruitment and retention to be ap-
24 pointed jointly by the President of the Senate and
25 the Speaker of the House of Representatives; 3 mem-
26 bers representing community-based facilities for per-
27 sons with mental retardation to be appointed jointly
28 by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the
29 House of Representatives; and one member representing
30 the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retarda-
31 tion to be appointed by the Commissioner of Mental
32 Health and Mental Retardation. All members of the ad-
33 visory committee, except for the representative from
34 the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retarda-
35 tion, shall receive per diem for days of attendance
36 at advisory committee meetings at the same rate as
37 legislative per diem and shall be reimbursed for
38 travel and expenses incurred in the performance of
39 their duties, as defined in the Maine Revised Stat-
40 utes, Title 5, section 12202.'

3 'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are
