18 Resolve, Authorizing a Study Relating to
19 Bioptics and Drivers' Licenses.

21 Commission established. Resolved: That there is
22 established the Commission on Bioptics; and be it
23 further

24 Membership. Resolved: That the commission shall
25 consist of the members of the Joint Standing Commit-
26 tee on Transportation, the Secretary of State or his
27 designee and one member representing the Medical Re-
28 view Board. The commission shall select a chairman
29 from among its members; and be it further

30 Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall
31 study whether the use of telescopic or bioptic lenses
32 may be used to meet minimum vision standards required
33 for licensure to operate a motor vehicle. If the
34 commission finds that the use of telescopic or
35 bioptic lenses may provide an acceptable mechanism to

1 meet vision requirements, it shall establish stan-
2 dards, including restrictions, for the use of the
3 lenses and carrier lenses to meet minimum vision re-
4 quirements, which standards shall be adopted by rule
5 by the Secretary of State; and be it further

6 Reports. Resolved: That the commission shall
7 present its findings, together with any recommended
8 legislation, to the First Regular Session of the
9 113th Legislature.
