4 This formula is based on the preceding year's sales. 5 Persons beginning in the business as a licensed vehi-6 cle dealer are subject to review after initial bond-7 ing depending on volume.

8 First time licensees are required to file a bond 9 based on projected sales to determine the amount of 10 the bond. All licensees shall be reviewed annually 11 by the Secretary of State to determine compliance 12 with the correct amount of the bonds.

13 Failure to maintain such a bond is grounds for immediate suspension of the dealer's license.

15 STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill amends existing bonding requirements 17 for vehicle dealers that provide surety bonds prior 18 to licensing to surety bonds after a violation of law 19 has taken place.

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
