SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1383, L.D. 1952,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for a Clean-up Program Concerning Natural Die-off of Fish in the Coastal Waters
of the State."

11 Amend the bill by striking out everything after 12 the enacting clause and before the statement of fact 13 and inserting in its place the following:

14 '12 MRSA §6132 is enacted to read:

15 §6132. Natural Fish Die-off Clean-up Program

16 Upon the request of any affected municipality, 17 the Department of Marine Resources shall assess the 18 extent and severity of public nuisance and potential 19 threats to public health posed by natural fish 20 die-offs. The department shall provide technical ad-21 vice to the affected municipalities in the conduct of 22 any clean-up or other mitigating measures.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the state-funded clean-up program proposed by the original bill and replace it with a program of the Department of Marine Resources assessment and technical advice. It is the intent of the Legislature that the costs of this limited program be covered by the department's existing resources.
