Scope of authorization. Notwithstanding sub-18 section 2, no dam may be operated by, leased to or 19 otherwise used for the benefit of any legal entity other than a municipality. This subsection shall not affect any licensing or certification proceeding presently under way before the Board of Environmental 20 21 22 23 Protection. 24 STATEMENT OF FACT The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the 2.5 26 legislative protection of natural resources on the 27 lower Penobscot River. The amendment makes it clear 28 that the bill does not apply to current applications 29 before state agencies. 30 6915031886
