COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 787, L.D. 1980, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Supplemental Allocations from the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund to Support Activities and Staff of the Board of Underground Oil Storage Tank Installers."

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 2, line 17 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in the Allocation by inserting after the 7th line the following:

'ATTORNEY GENERAL, DEPARTMENT OF

Allocates funds to support an Assistant Attorney General used to recover damage and clean-up costs.

2 the joint standing committee of the Legislature hav-  
3 ing jurisdiction over natural resources on progress  
4 in recovering damages and clean-up costs from those  
5 persons causing underground oil pollution problems.  
6 The role of the Assistant Attorney General assigned  
7 to this purpose shall be presented. The department  
8 shall make the report on or before March 1, 1987.'

9 STATEMENT OF FACT

10 The purpose of this amendment is to correct an  
11 arithmetic error in the original bill and to add  
12 funding for the 2nd year of an existing position in  
13 the Attorney General's office. The Assistant Attor-  
14 ney General is responsible for recovery of damages  
15 and clean-up costs from polluters of ground water.  
16 The amendment further requires the Department of En-  
17 vironmental Protection to report on progress in re-  
18 covery of these costs.
