20 the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund to
21 Support Activities and Staff of the
22 Board of Underground Oil Storage Tank

25 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
26 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
27 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

28 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
29 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

30 Whereas, the Board of Underground Oil Storage
31 Tank Installers is required by the Maine Revised
32 Statutes, Title 32, chapter 105, to certify individu-
33 als as underground tank installers by May 1, 1986, to
34 ensure that all underground tanks are properly and
35 safely installed within the State; and

1 Whereas, the Board of Underground Oil Storage
2 Tank Installers is in immediate need of funding for
3 expenses and for support staff in order to carry out
4 its legislative mandate; and

5 Whereas, revenue from application fees will not
6 be forthcoming in a timely fashion or in adequate
7 levels to support the board's expenses and support
8 staff; and

9 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
10 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
11 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
12 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
13 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
14 therefore,

15 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
16 follows:

17 Allocation. The following funds are allocated
18 from the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund to carry out
19 the purpose of this Act. Any unexpended balance
20 shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing car-
21 rying account until the purpose of this Act has been
22 accomplished.
