18 AN ACT to Repeal Certain Rule-making
19 Authority Dealing with Staffing,
20 Student/Teacher Ratios and Minimum School
21 Size at Elementary and Secondary Schools.

23 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
24 follows:

25 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4502, sub-§5, ¶¶B and E, as
26 enacted by PL 1983, c. 859, Pt. A, §§20 and 25, are
27 repealed.

28 Sec. 2. Application. Any rule promulgated pur-
29 suant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, sec-
30 tion 4502, subsection 5, paragraphs B and E, which is
31 in effect on the effective date of this Act has no
32 effect and is void.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to repeal retroac-
3 tively the authority of the State Board of Education
4 and the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Ser-
5 vices to set by rule standards concerning staffing,
6 student/teacher ratios and minimum school size at el-
7 elementary and secondary schools.

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
