No person may sell, offer for sale or serve is any retail store, hotel, restaurant or other publicating place any food or food product, whether or no in package form, containing any sulfite unless:	С
1. Packaged. The package in which that food of food product is offered for sale conspicuously bear a label or stamp indicating that the food or food product contains sulfite; or	s
2. Nonpackaged. Where the food or food product offered for consumption is not packaged, a conspicution out label or sign is placed on, immediately next to or on the menu, indicating that the food or food product contains sulfite.	<u>-</u>
