The commission of 13 members, who shall be appointed shall consist as follows: The Commissioner of Environmental the Commissioner of Human Services and the tection, State Geologist or their designees shall be members of the commission. The President of the Senate shall appoint 3 Senators, 2 from the majority party and one from the minority party; one person from an organizathat holds a license for the use of radioactive material; and one person from the public. general The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall ap-3 Representatives, 2 from the majority party, from and one from the minority party; one person organization that holds a license for the use of radioactive material; and one person from the general The terms of legislative members of the Commission shall expire the first Wednesday in December 1986, and in even numbered years . The terms of the public member appointed by the President of the Senate and the licensee member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall expire December 31, 1986, and every 2 years thereafter; and the terms the public member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the licensee member pointed by the President of the Senate shall expire December 31, 1987, and every 2 years thereafter. Notwithstanding this subsection, any public member or licensee member may be removed by the appointing authority, at the pleasure of the appointing authority, and a new member may be appointed to complete the term of the preceding appointee. Members may continto serve until their replacements are designated. Vacancies shall be filled by the appointing authority to complete the term of the preceding appointee.
- The commission shall elect a chairman from its legislative membership. The Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall serve as vice-chairman.
 - Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
