This amendment permits a court sentencing a person convicted of the crimes of unlawful trafficking in scheduled drugs, aggrevated trafficking or furnishing scheduled drugs, unlawfully furnishing scheduled drugs, or unlawful possession of certain scheduled drugs to set a fine equal to the value of the scheduled drugs.
