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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 797, L.D.
2004, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Drug Enforcement
Law."

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Amend the bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the
following:

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'17-A MRSA §1301, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

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5. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
section, any person convicted of a crime under sec-
tion 1103, 1105, 1106 or 1107 may be sentenced to pay
a fine of an amount equal to the value at the time of
the offense of the scheduled drug or drugs upon which
the conviction is based.

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When the court imposes a fine under this subsection,
the court shall make a finding as to the value of the
scheduled drug or drugs. If the record does not con-
tain sufficient evidence to support a finding, the
court may conduct, in connection with its imposition
of a sentence, a hearing on this issue.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 797, L.D. 2004

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment permits a court sentencing a person convicted of the crimes of unlawful trafficking in scheduled drugs, aggravated trafficking or furnishing scheduled drugs, unlawfully furnishing scheduled drugs, or unlawful possession of certain scheduled drugs to set a fine equal to the value of the scheduled drugs.
