3 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment "grandfathers" from the mandatory training requirements for part-time law enforcement officers any person who was employed continously as a part-time law enforcement officer between January 1, 1970, and December 31, 1985. Any person who was employed as a part-time law enforcement officer prior to Septmeber 14, 1979, but following January 1, 1970, or who was initially employed as a part-time or reserve law enforcement officer between September 14, 1979, and September 22, 1983, is required to be certified by the academy, but may apply for a waiver. The waiver procedure will allow eligible part-time law enforcement officers to waive attendance at academy training programs, but the eligible officers will still be required to fulfill the testing requirements and present certificates of comparable training or achievement as required by the board of trustees.

Any person who was initially employed as of September 23, 1983, as a part-time law enforcement officer is required to fulfill the mandatory training requirements for part-time law enforcement officers.
